

## The Municipal Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie

By-law No. 110-2016

Being a By-law to Authorize the Entry Into and Execution of an Agreement with Her Majesty the Queen in Right of Ontario as Represented by the Minister of Agriculture, Food and Rural Affairs Under the Ontario Community Infrastructure Fund

Whereas the Government of Ontario through the Ministry of Agriculture, Food and Rural Affairs created the Ontario Community Infrastructure Fund (OCIF) – Formula Based Component to address critical core infrastructure needs in relation to roads, bridges, water and wastewater; further strengthen municipal asset management practices within small communities; and help small communities use a broad range of financial tools to address critical infrastructure challenges and provide long-term financial support for the rehabilitation and repair of core infrastructure for those in most need; and

**Whereas** the Town of Fort Erie is eligible to receive funding under the Formula-Based Component of the Ontario Community Infrastructure Fund in the form of an annual grant allocation based on the allocation notice, subject to the execution of an OCIF Agreement with the Ministry; and

**Whereas** it is deemed desirable to enter into the said Agreement to receive funding under the Formula-Based Component of the Ontario Community Infrastructure Fund;

Now therefore the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie enacts as follows:

- 1. That an Agreement with Her Majesty the Queen in Right of Ontario as Represented by the Minister of Agriculture, Food and Rural Affairs under the Formula-Based Component of the Ontario Community Infrastructure Fund for an annual grant allocation based on the allocation notice, is authorized and approved.
- 2. That the Mayor and Clerk are authorized and directed to execute the said Agreement, in a form satisfactory to the Director, Corporate Services/Treasurer and the Town Solicitor, and to affix the corporate seal thereto.
- **That** the Clerk of the Town is authorized to effect any minor modifications, corrections or omissions, solely of an administrative, numerical, grammatical, semantical or descriptive nature to this by-law or its schedules after the passage of this by-law.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 11<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2016.
