

## The Municipal Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie

By-law No. 31-2017

Being a By-law to Authorize the Entry into a Lease Agreement with 1322977 Ontario Inc. (Steve & Nada Sustic) for Parking Purposes (Palmwood Hotel – Crystal Beach Waterfront Park)

Whereas the lands described as part of Water Lot 4, Plan 544 Bertie; Fort Erie, and part of the Private Entrance to Lots Plan 410 Bertie aka Front Avenue; Fort Erie forms part of the Town's facility known as "Crystal Beach Waterfront Park" (the "parking area"); and

**Whereas** 1322977 Ontario Inc. (the "Owner") owns abutting lands to the east described as Lots 11 & 12, Plan 410 Bertie; Fort Erie, municipally known as 3823 Terrace Lane; and

Whereas the Town of Fort Erie entered into a Lease Agreement dated July 17, 2001 with the Owner's predecessors, Stjepan (Steve) Sustic and Nada Sustic, for the parking area, having an expiry date of July 16, 2021; and

**Whereas** the Owner is desirous of entering into a new Lease Agreement for the parking area with a new term of 20 years;

**Whereas** Report No. PDS-17-2017 was considered at the Council-in-Committee Meeting held on March 6, 2017 and subsequently approved by Council, to enter into a new Lease Agreement with the Owner; and

**Whereas** it is deemed desirable to enter into a new Lease Agreement with a 20 year term;

**Now therefore** the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie enacts as follows:

- 1. That the entry into a Lease Agreement with 1322977 Ontario Inc. for the provision of parking in a designated area of the Town's facility known as "Crystal Beach Waterfront Park", for a term of twenty (20) years, and in a form acceptable to the Town Solicitor, is authorized and approved.
- **2. That** the Mayor and Clerk are authorized and directed to execute the said Lease Agreement and affix the corporate seal thereto.

**3. That** the Clerk of the Town is authorized to effect any minor modifications, corrections or omissions, solely of an administrative, numerical, grammatical, semantical or descriptive nature to this by-law or its schedules after the passage of this by-law.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 27<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2017.
