By-law No. 83-2017

Being a By-law to Appoint the Director, Infrastructure Services to The Regional Municipality of Niagara Inter-Municipal Transit Working Group

Whereas The Regional Municipality of Niagara approved Report PW 29-2017 at its meeting held June 29, 2017 which outlined the Inter-Municipal Transit (IMT) – Phase 2 Update: Triple Majority and Next Steps, now that the Region has been granted authority to establish, operate and maintain an IMT system; and

Whereas The Regional Municipality of Niagara requires each of the 12 area municipalities to select one staff representative to sit as a member of the Inter-Municipal Transit Working Group by July 28, 2017; and

Whereas it is deemed expedient to appoint the Director, Infrastructure Services to The Regional Municipality of Niagara Inter-Municipal Transit Working Group;

Now therefore the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie enacts as follows:

- **1. That** the Director, Infrastructure Services be appointed to The Regional Municipality of Niagara Inter-Municipal Transit Working Group.
- 2. That the Clerk of the Town is authorized to effect any minor modifications, corrections or omissions, solely of an administrative, numerical, grammatical, semantical or descriptive nature to this by-law or its schedules after the passage of this by-law.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 17th day of July, 2017.
