



The Municipal Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie

By-law No. 135-2017

Being a By-law to Delegate Authority for Tax Collection Powers and Duties and to Repeal By-law No. 6-2003

Whereas By-law No. 6-2003 was passed by the Municipal Council of the Town of Fort Erie on the 13th day of January, 2003 to delegate tax collection powers and duties which named specific individuals; and

Whereas due to staffing changes it is expedient to delegate authority to specific staff positions; and

Whereas Report No. CS-26-2017 was considered at the Council-in-Committee Meeting held on December 4, 2017, and subsequently approved by Council, to delegate authority with respect to tax collection powers and duties; and

Whereas it is deemed expedient to delegate the powers and duties of the Treasurer under the *Municipal Act* or any other *Act* with respect to the collection of taxes;

Now therefore the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie enacts as follows:

1. **That** all of the powers and duties of the Treasurer of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie under the *Municipal Act, 2001* or any other *Act* with respect to the collection of taxes are delegated to the Manager, Revenue and Collections and Senior Revenue Clerk II - Tax of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie as prescribed by the Treasurer.
2. **That** By-law No. 6-2003 is repealed.
3. **That** the Clerk of the Town is authorized to effect any minor modifications, corrections or omissions, solely of an administrative, numerical, grammatical, semantical or descriptive nature to this by-law or its schedules after the passage of this by-law.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 11th day of December, 2017.
