

The Town of Fort Erie's Accessibility Advisory Committee (AAC) has received limited funding to provide temporary ramps to help increase access into stores with one step that meet the criteria (2"-9").

The AAC will also be providing marketing materials (stickers, media releases, notation on the Town's business directory that the store now has a barrier free access).

By entering into an agreement with StopGap Foundation, a ramp will be designed specifically for your entry way. This does not trigger any other accessibility requirements as the ramp is made available on a temporary basis.

Up to 15 free ramps are available. Applicants must meet the following eligibility criteria.

- o Businesses and organizations must be within the Town of Fort Erie
- Must have a single step between 2" and 9" tall from the walkway to the front entrance, or the entrance most commonly used by the public
- Businesses and organizations must carry insurance
- Businesses and organizations must deploy the ramp temporarily when requested and bring the ramp back in doors when not in use so as not to create any additional barriers along pathways

The Town recognizes that preventing new barriers, reducing and removing existing barriers, and enhancing access is essential to providing increased opportunities that foster independence, inclusion and dignity for people of all ages and abilities.
