





	<p><u>NATURE OF PROJECT</u></p> <p>The Town of Fort Erie is considering options to licence short term rentals, potential rules that need to be adhered to by short term rental owners and how these rules can be enforced to help minimize impacts within the community. Additional staffing will also be considered.</p>
	<p>WHAT IS A SHORT TERM RENTAL:</p> <p>A short-term rental or vacation rental is the renting out of a home, apartment, or condominium for a short-period of time. The property will usually rent out on a weekly or nightly basis.</p>
	<p><u>GETTING MORE INFORMATION</u></p> <p>Input on the short term rental regulation, licencing, and enforcement options is welcome and encouraged. You can provide input by speaking at the public meeting or by making a written submission to the Town prior to the meeting.</p> <p>A copy of the Information Report will be available to the public by 5:00 PM on January 11, 2019. The information report will be available in the Council agenda portion of the Town's Web Site: www.forterie.ca or from the Planning and Development Services Department.</p>
