

## **Volunteer Firefighter**

In order to fill existing and impending vacancies, Fort Erie Fire and Emergency Services is accepting applications from persons interested in serving the community as a Volunteer Firefighter.

Applicants who make it through the screening process must successfully complete a five (5) month recruit program followed by a twelve (12) month probationary period, then dedicate a specific number of hours per month to training, fire station duties and meetings.

As a volunteer firefighter you may be called upon at any time twenty-four (24) hours a day, seven (7) days a week, to respond to various types of emergency situations. In addition, you will enjoy the camaraderie and social benefits that come with membership in our firefighters' associations.

You must have an Ontario Secondary School Diploma or equivalent, be at least 18 years of age and live full-time in the Town of Fort Erie. You are self-confident, reliable and understand the importance of teamwork and cooperation. You have the ability to read, understand and apply technical procedures and guidelines and a willingness to learn and practice new skills. You must possess a valid, unrestricted Class "G" drivers' license and have or be willing to upgrade to a DZ. You are also required to provide a satisfactory police background check and pass medical and physical evaluations.
