BY-LAW NO. 23-10

BEING A BY-LAW TO RE-ESTABLISH AND APPOINT MEMBERS TO THE SENIOR CITIZENS ADVISORY COMMITTEE AND TO REPEAL BY-LAW NO. 113-95 AND AMEND BY-LAW NO. 145-06

WHEREAS Section 107 (1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, as amended, provides that despite any provision of this or any other Act relating to the giving of grants or aid by a municipality, subject to Section 106, a municipality may make grants, on such terms as to security and otherwise as the council considers appropriate, to any person, group or body, including a fund, within or outside the boundaries of the municipality for any purpose that council considers to be in the interests of the municipality, and

WHEREAS By-law No. 113-95 provides for the establishment and appointment of members to the Senior Citizens Advisory Committee, and

WHEREAS Report No. CS-07-10 was approved at the Council-in-Committee Meeting of February 16, 2010, directing the alteration of the composition of the Fort Erie Senior Citizens Advisory Committee as set out in the Report, and

WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to re-establish the Senior Citizens Advisory Committee, define its purpose and composition and approve rules of procedure;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Town of Fort Erie hereby enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** the Senior Citizens Advisory Committee be re-established.
2. **THAT** the role of the Senior Citizens Advisory Committee shall be to establish a mechanism to fairly and equitably distribute financial assistance provided by the Town of Fort Erie to “Assist the Aged”, to determine the need for increased senior citizen services and to assist in establishing mechanisms to adopt recommendations.
3. **THAT** the Senior Citizens Advisory Committee shall be comprised of the following:

Seniors Group with less than 100 members	1 Committee Member
Seniors Group with more than 100 members	2 Committee Members
Community Representatives (at large)	4 Committee Members
Member(s) of Council	1 Committee Member

presently including, but not limited to the following:

- 1 rep – “Dandi-Lions”;
- 3 reps – “Black Creek Leisure Homes Seniors Group”;
- 1 rep – “Harmony Hill” of Fort Erie;
- 2 reps – “Italo Canadian Seniors Club”;
- 1 rep – “96’ers” of Fort Erie and 1 additional rep for the period ending with the 2014 term;
- 2 reps – “Beachcombers” of Ridgeway;
- 1 rep – “Royal Canadian Legion Branch 71”;
- 1 rep – “Fort Erie Native Friendship Centre Seniors”;

4. THAT the following persons be and they are hereby appointed to the Senior Citizens Advisory Committee for the period ending January 31st, 2011 or until such time as new appointments have been made by Council, and that the vacancies which currently exist as a result of the alteration of the composition of the Committee shall be filled by resolution following the selection process:

5. THAT By-law No. 113-95 as amended be repealed.


6. THAT Section 22 of "Part 1 – External" of Appendix "E" to By-law No. 145-06, as amended, being a By-law to Adopt Council Rules of Procedure, is repealed and the following substituted therefor:

"22. SENIOR CITIZEN ADVISORY COMMITTEE to be comprised of four (4) Community Representatives (at large), one (1) member of Council, one (1) Committee member to be nominated by each Seniors Group in the Town of Fort Erie with less than one hundred (100) members and two (2) Committee members to be nominated by each Seniors Group in the Town of Fort Erie with more than one hundred (100) members."

7. THAT pursuant to the provisions of Sections 23.1 to 23.5 inclusive of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, as amended, the Clerk of the Town of Fort Erie is hereby authorized to effect any minor modifications or corrections solely of an administrative, numerical, grammatical, semantical or descriptive nature or kind to this by-law or its schedules as such may be determined to be necessary after the passage of this by-law.
