What is the Purpose of the Meeting?

The Council of the Town of Fort Erie will hold a public meeting pursuant to subsection 26(3) of the *Planning Act* to formally kick-off the process to review and update the Town of Fort Erie's Official Plan. The Official Plan applies Town-wide.

The meeting will include a presentation that will introduce the Official Plan Review project and discuss its themes, guiding principles, direction and any revisions that may be required. The Town needs your help to understand what is important to the community, what should be explored as part of the project and how you envision the future of Fort Erie!

Why Are We Reviewing the Official Plan?

The Town of Fort Erie is initiating its Official Plan Conformity Review pursuant to Section 26 of the *Planning Act*.

Fort Erie has to update the official plan to ensure that it aligns with Provincial and Regional plans. Additionally, the Official Plan is updated to make sure that the evolving needs and priorities of the community are met.

Have Your Say!

Following a presentation from staff at the Council-in-Committee Meeting, community members will be invited to share ideas that should be explored as part of this Review. This is the first of many opportunities to participate in the Official Plan Review.

- Attend **in person** at Town Hall or attend **virtually** through Video Teleconference (Zoom Video platform). A video recording of the meeting will also be made available after the meeting and archived on the Town's website.
- Any person may attend the Council-in-Committee Meeting and/or make written or verbal representation regarding what revisions may be required as part of a proposed update to the Town's Official Plan. Individuals who wish to provide verbal representation may do so in-person or provide a remote (live) deputation through the Zoom Video platform during the Council meeting.
