

The Municipal Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie

By-law No. 3-2018

Being a By-law to Exempt Lot 1 in Plan 59M-263 from Part Lot Control 5 & 7 Bardol Avenue

Starward Holdings Limited (Brandon Campbell)

Whereas the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie deems that the lands described in Section 1 of this By-law should be exempted from the provisions of Subsection 5 of Section 50 of the *Planning Act* since such lands are to be used for a semi-detached dwelling unit as permitted by Zoning By-law No. 129-90 as amended;

Now therefore the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie enacts as follows:

- 1. **That** the provisions of Subsection 5 of Section 50 of the *Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.13* as amended shall not apply to the lands described as follows:
 - (a) Lot 1, Plan 59M-263, Fort Erie, being all of PIN 64212-0121 (LT).

for the purpose of creating two (2) lots for a semi-detached dwelling unit as follows:

- i) Parts 1 and 2 on Reference Plan 59R-16018, and
- 2. **That** in accordance with Subsection 7.3 of Section 50 of the *Planning Act, R.S.O.* 1990, c.P. 13 as amended, this By-law shall expire 1 year from the date of the registration of this by-law in the Land Registry Office at which time Subsection 5 of Section 50 of the *Planning Act R.S.O.* 1990 shall apply to those lands in the registered plan described in Section 1 of this by-law.
- 3. **That** upon final passage of this by-law, the Town Solicitor shall cause this By-law to be registered in the local Land Registry Office.

4. **That** the Clerk of the Town is authorized to effect any minor modifications, corrections or omissions, solely of an administrative, numerical, grammatical, semantical or descriptive nature to this by-law or its schedules after the passage of this by-law.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 22nd day of January, 2018.
