By-law No. 103-2018

Being a By-law to Amend By-law No. 114-2016 To Adopt a Winter Control Plan for 2016-2020 (Sidewalk Snow Plowing)

Whereas By-law No. 114-2016 was passed by the Municipal Council of the Town of Fort Erie on the 24th day of October, 2016 to adopt a Winter Control Plan for 2016-2020; and

Whereas By-law No. 23-2018 was passed by the Municipal Council of the Town of Fort Erie on the 12th day of February, 2018 to amend the Winter Control Plan including sidewalk snow plowing; and

Whereas effective April 1, 2018 Ontario Regulation 232/02 was amended to provide that the Maintenance Standards include all sidewalks, and accordingly all sidewalks in the Town of Fort Erie must be cleared of snow and sanded/salted when icy conditions prevail within 48 hours of the end of an event; and

Whereas it is deemed necessary to amend the Winter Control Plan to provide for the expanded sidewalk snow plowing;

Now therefore the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie enacts as follows:

1. **That** Tab 11 of By-law No. 114-2016 is repealed and replaced with Tab 11 attached to this by-law as Schedule "A".
2. **That** the Clerk of the Town is authorized to effect any minor modifications, corrections or omissions, solely of an administrative, numerical, grammatical, semantical or descriptive nature to this by-law or its schedules after the passage of this by-law.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 27th day of August, 2018.
