

The Municipal Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie

By-law No. 140-2018

Being a By-law to Appoint George Stojanovic and Kevin Boucock as Municipal Law Enforcement Officers for the Town of Fort Erie (Winter Parking) and to Repeal By-law No. 17-2018

Whereas the Town's Traffic By-law No. 2000-89, as amended, regulates overnight parking on streets between November 1st and March 31st of each year; and

Whereas By-law No. 17-2018 was passed by the Municipal Council of the Town of Fort Erie on the 22nd day of January, 2018 to appoint Douglas Campbell and Kevin Boucock as Municipal Law Enforcement Officers for the Town of Fort Erie for the purposes of enforcing overnight parking between November 1st and March 31st of each year; and

Whereas Douglas Campbell has retired from employment with the Town of Fort Erie; and

Whereas it is desirable to appoint George Stojanovic and Kevin Boucock as Municipal Law Enforcement Officers for the Town of Fort Erie for the purposes of enforcing overnight parking between November 1st and March 31st of each year and repeal By-law No. 17-2018;

Now therefore the Council of the Town of Fort Erie enacts as follows:

- **1. That** George Stojanovic and Kevin Boucock are appointed as Municipal Law Enforcement Officers for the Town of Fort Erie for the purposes of enforcing the provisions of Traffic By-law No. 2000-89, as amended, relating to overnight parking between November 1st and March 31st of each year.
- 2. That By-law No. 17-2018 is repealed.
- 3. That the Clerk of the Town is authorized to effect any minor modifications, corrections or omissions solely of an administrative, numerical, grammatical, semantical or descriptive nature to this by-law or its schedules after the passage of this by-law.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 19th day of November, 2018.
