## By-law No. 130-2019

### Being a By-law to Amend By-law No. 37-2016 To Adopt a Street Lighting Policy (Delegation of Authority)

---

**Whereas** By-law No. 37-2016 was passed by the Municipal Council of the Town of Fort Erie on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2016 to adopt a Street Lighting Policy for the Town of Fort Erie; and

**Whereas** some of the street light products identified in Appendix “3” and “4” to Schedule “A” to the by-law, are and/or will be discontinued as the suppliers provide more efficient products; and

**Whereas** it is deemed desirable to amend By-law No. 37-2016 accordingly, to include a provision to delegate authority to the Director of Infrastructure Services or designate, in his/her absence, to approve updated street light products as they become available from suppliers;

**Now therefore** the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie enacts as follows:

1. **That** By-law No. 37-2016 is amended by inserting the following section immediately following Section 1:

“2. **That** the Director of Infrastructure Services or designate in his/her absence, is delegated the authority to approve updated street light products as they become available from suppliers.”

and the balance of the sections of the by-law are renumbered accordingly.

2. **That** the Clerk of the Town is authorized to effect any minor modifications, corrections or omissions, solely of an administrative, numerical, grammatical, semantical or descriptive nature to this by-law or its schedules after the passage of this by-law.

**Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of September, 2019.**
