

## The Municipal Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie

By-law No. 51-2020

## Being a By-law to Amend Parks & Beaches By-law No. 119-03, as amended (Residing in Parks)

**Whereas** By-law No. 119-03, as amended, was passed by the Municipal Council of the Town of Fort Erie on May 26, 2003, to regulate the use of parks and beaches in the Town of Fort Erie; and

**Whereas** at the Council meeting held on May 19, 2020, Resolution No. 12B was passed as follows:

"That: Parks and Beaches By-law No. 119-03, as amended, be further amended to restrict

any person(s) from staying in any park as their place of residence at any time, and

further

**That:** An administrative penalty be implemented in the amount of \$100, and be issued to

any person who violates this provision.", and

**Whereas** it is deemed necessary to amend Parks & Beaches By-law No. 119-03, as amended, to implement the said Resolution;

**Now therefore** the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie enacts as follows:

- 1. That Parks & Beaches By-law No. 119-03, as amended, is further amended by adding the following definition immediately following Subsection 1 (h), and the remaining subsections are re-lettered accordingly:
  - "(j) "Place of Residence" means the place where a person who does not have a usual place of residence in a dwelling unit, makes his/her home, whether during the daytime or overnight."
- **2. That** Parks & Beaches By-law No. 119-03, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following Subsection immediately following prohibition Subsection 3 (p):
  - "(q) stay in any park as their place of residence at any time."
- **3.** That Schedule "B" to Parks & Beaches By-law No. 119-03, is further amended by adding the following Administrative Penalty:

That** the Clerk of the Town is authorized to effect any minor modifications, corrections or omissions, solely of an administrative, numerical, grammatical, semantical or descriptive nature to this by-law or its schedules after the passage of this by-law.
