



The Municipal Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie

By-law No. 24-2021

Being a By-law to Authorize the Sale of Part of Lot 583, Plan 475 (0 Maple Avenue) to George Burgman and Raechal Eric

Whereas By-law No. 60-2017 establishes a policy for the sale of land owned by The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie (the "Policy"); and

Whereas Report No. PDS-07-2021 was considered and approved at the Regular Council Meeting held on January 18, 2021, to authorize the sale of lands on the south side of Maple Avenue, for the appraised value of \$7,900.00, plus HST, if applicable, to George Edward Burgman and Raechal Geneva Rose Eric, subject to the lands being required to merge with the purchasers' abutting lands; and

Whereas it is deemed desirable to enter into an Agreement of Purchase and Sale with George Edward Burgman and Raechal Geneva Rose Eric for the sale of the said property;

Now therefore the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie enacts as follows:

1. **That** the entry into an Agreement of Purchase and Sale with George Edward Burgman and Raechal Geneva Rose Eric (the "purchasers") in the amount of \$7,900.00 plus HST for the lands described as Lot 583, Plan 475, Bertie; Fort Erie, being all of PIN 64196-0015 (LT) in a form satisfactory to the Town Solicitor, is authorized and approved, subject to the lands merging in title with the purchasers' abutting property and the purchasers being responsible for all associated costs.
2. **That** the Town Solicitor, or her designate, is authorized and directed to execute the Agreement of Purchase and Sale and all other documentation necessary to complete the transaction, and to affix the corporate seal thereto.
3. **That** the proceeds from the sale shall be credited to the Major Capital Expenditure Reserve Fund of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie.
4. **That** this by-law shall expire one (1) year from the date of passage if the purchasers have not completed the transaction.

5. **That** the Clerk of the Town is authorized to effect any minor modifications, corrections or omissions, solely of an administrative, numerical, grammatical, semantical or descriptive nature to this by-law or its schedules after the passage of this by-law.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 22nd day of February, 2021.
