

The Municipal Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie

By-law No. 46-2021

Being a By-law to Authorize the Entry into an Amending Agreement with Dr. Nazia Pirzada to Amend the Grant Funding Agreement Authorized by By-law No. 66-2020

Whereas By-law No. 123-2019 was passed by the Municipal Council of the Town of Fort Erie on August 26, 2019, to adopt a Physician Recruitment, Retention and Medical Education Financial Incentive Guideline for the Town of Fort Erie; and

Whereas Report No. CAO-05-2020 was considered and approved at the Council-in-Committee Meeting held on February 10, 2020 recommending the entry into a Grant Funding Agreement with Dr. Nazia Pirzada, for physician recruitment, in an amount not to exceed \$75,000.00; and

Whereas By-law No. 66-2020 was passed by the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie on July 20, 2020 to authorize the entry into a Grant Funding Agreement with Dr. Nazia Pirzada; and

Whereas Report No. CAO-08-2021 was considered and approved at the Council-in-Committee Meeting held on April 12, 2021 recommending the entry into an Amending Agreement with Dr. Nazia Pirzada to amend the Grant Funding Agreement authorized by By-law No. 66-2020 and to provide for payment of the final \$45,000.00 in 2021;

Now therefore the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie enacts as follows:

- 1. That the entry into an Amending Agreement with Dr. Nazia Pirzada to amend the Grant Funding Agreement authorized by By-law No. 66-2020 to accelerate the grant funding payment schedule and provide for payment of the final \$45,000.00 in 2021 and require that Dr. Nazia Pirzada provide five (5) years return of service from the date of the initial \$30,000.00 payment, in a form satisfactory to the Town Solicitor, is authorized and approved.
- 2. That the Mayor and Clerk are authorized and directed to execute the Amending Agreement and to affix the corporate seal thereto.
- **3. That** the Clerk of the Town is authorized to effect any minor modifications, corrections or omissions, solely of an administrative, numerical, grammatical, semantical or descriptive nature to this by-law or its schedules after the passage of this by-law.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 26th day of April, 2021.
