

## The Municipal Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie

By-law No. 48-2021

## Being a By-law to Authorize the Sale of Part of Lot 85, Plan 448, Bertie (0 Seymour Avenue) to Jacqueline Denham

**Whereas** By-law No. 60-2017 establishes a policy for the sale of land owned by The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie (the "Policy"); and

**Whereas** Report No. PDS-25-2021 was considered and approved at the Regular Council Meeting held on March 22, 2021, to authorize the sale of lands on the north side of Seymour Avenue, for the appraised value of \$1,500.00, plus HST, to Jacqueline Denham, subject to the lands being required to merge with the purchaser's abutting lands; and

**Whereas** it is deemed desirable to enter into an Agreement of Purchase and Sale with Jacqueline Denham for the sale of the said property;

**Now therefore** the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie enacts as follows:

- 1. That the entry into an Agreement of Purchase and Sale with Jacqueline Denham (the "purchaser") in the amount of \$1,500.00 plus HST for the lands described as Part of Lot 85, Plan 448, Bertie, as in BB73743; Fort Erie, being all of PIN 64236-0374 (LT) in a form satisfactory to the Town Solicitor, is authorized and approved, subject to the lands merging in title with the purchaser's abutting property and the purchaser being responsible for all associated costs.
- 2. That the Town Solicitor, or her designate, is authorized and directed to execute the Agreement of Purchase and Sale and all other documentation necessary to complete the transaction, and to affix the corporate seal thereto.
- **That** the proceeds from the sale shall be credited to the Major Capital Expenditure Reserve Fund of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie.
- **4. That** this by-law shall expire one (1) year from the date of passage if the purchaser has not completed the transaction.

**5. That** the Clerk of the Town is authorized to effect any minor modifications, corrections or omissions, solely of an administrative, numerical, grammatical, semantical or descriptive nature to this by-law or its schedules after the passage of this by-law.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 26<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2021.
