By-law No. 61-2021

## Being a By-law to Appoint Temporary Municipal Law Enforcement Officers for 2021 Summer Season

**Whereas** the *Police Services Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.15, section 15 provides that a municipal council may appoint persons to enforce the by-laws of the municipality and that municipal law enforcement officers are peace officers for the purpose of enforcing municipal by-laws; and

**Whereas** the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, section 101 provides that a municipal law enforcement officer may provide evidence in the impoundment of parked vehicles; and

**Whereas** it is deemed desirable to appoint temporary Municipal Law Enforcement Officers for the 2021 summer season;

**Now therefore** the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie enacts as follows:

- 1. That each of the following persons is appointed a temporary Municipal Law Enforcement Officer for The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie and is also appointed a temporary Provincial Offences Officer while in the discharge of their duties until on or about September 30, 2021or as may be extended by the Chief Administrative Officer:
  - a. Corey Fitzgerald
  - b. Drake Quinn
  - c. James Casselman
  - d. Joachim Veltman
  - e. Matthew Woehl
- 2. That the Clerk of the Town is authorized to effect any minor modifications, corrections or omissions, solely of an administrative, numerical, grammatical, semantical or descriptive nature to this by-law or its schedules after the passage of this by-law.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 17<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2021.
