By-law No. 98-2021

Being a By-law to Amend Animal By-law No. 73-2021 (Exception to Number of Dogs Permitted in Household or on Premises)

Whereas By-law No. 73-2021 was passed by the Municipal Council of the Town of Fort Erie on May 31, 2021 to provide for the regulation of animal welfare, governing the care, licensing, and regulating of dogs, cats, and other animals; and

Whereas Council considered and approved Resolution No. 6 at the Council meeting held on July 19, 2021 to provide that the Animal By-law No. 73-2021, be amended by changing Part III, 8. (6) b (iii) "for agricultural property: a minimum of five (5) acres of land;" to "for property: a minimum of three (3) acres of land"; and

Whereas it is deemed desirable to make the aforesaid amendment to By-law No. 73-2021; and

Now therefore the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie enacts as follows:

1. **That** Animal By-law No. 73-2021 is amended by repealing Subsection 8. (6) (b) (iii) and replacing it with the following:

"(iii) for property: a minimum of three (3) acres of land;"

2. **That** the Clerk of the Town is authorized to effect any minor modifications, corrections or omissions, solely of an administrative, numerical, grammatical, semantical or descriptive nature to this by-law or its schedules after the passage of this by-law.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 23rd day of August, 2021.
