



The Municipal Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie

By-law No. 151-2021

Being a By-law to Appoint James McCaffery as a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer, and Coordinator, Law Enforcement for The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie and to Repeal By-law No. 69-2020

Whereas subsection 15(1) of the *Police Services Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.15, provides that a municipal council may appoint persons to enforce the by-laws of the municipality; and

Whereas subsection 15(2) of the said *Act* further provides that municipal law enforcement officers are peace officers for the purpose of enforcing municipal by-laws; and

Whereas subsection 1(1) of the *Provincial Offences Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.33, provides that "provincial offences officer" means a municipal law enforcement officer while in the discharge of his or her duties; and

Whereas subsection 1(1) of the *Building Code Act*, 1992, S.O. 1992, c.23 provides that an "officer" means a "property standards officer" who has been assigned the responsibility of administering and enforcing by-laws under section 15.1 of the *Act*; and

Whereas By-law No. 69-2020 was passed by the Municipal Council of the Town of Fort Erie on the 20th day of July, 2020 to appoint Paul Chudoba as Municipal Law Enforcement Officer and Coordinator, Law Enforcement for the Town of Fort Erie; and

Whereas Paul Chudoba has left the employment of the Town of Fort Erie; and

Whereas it is deemed desirable to appoint James McCaffery as a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer and Coordinator, Law Enforcement for the Town of Fort Erie;

Now therefore the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie enacts as follows:

- 1. That** James McCaffery is appointed as a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer, and Coordinator, Law Enforcement for The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie effective upon the passage of this by-law.
- 2. That** By-law No. 69-2020 is repealed.

- 3. That** the Clerk of the Town is authorized to effect any minor modifications, corrections or omissions, solely of an administrative, numerical, grammatical, semantical or descriptive nature to this by-law or its schedules after the passage of this by-law.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 13th day of December, 2021.
