## By-law No. 153-2021

## Being a By-law to Amend Animal By-law No. 73-2021 (Dogs in Parks)

**Whereas** By-law No. 73-2021, was passed on May 31, 2021, to regulate the use of parks and beaches in the Town of Fort Erie; and

**Whereas** at the Council meeting held on November 22, 2021, Resolution No.14 was passed to amend By-law No.73-2021, as amended, to add A.C. Douglas Park 2 to the list of permitted parks that allow dogs on leashes; and

Whereas it is deemed desirable to amend By-law No. 73-2021 accordingly;

**Now therefore** the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie enacts as follows:

- **1. That** Part III Section 8 (7) of By-law No. 73-2021, as amended, is repealed and replaced with the following:
  - "(7) No person shall permit a dog to be on or in any cemetery, public beach, or park within the Town, except for the following parks: Lions Sugarbowl Park, Battle of Ridgeway Park, The Friendship Trail, and A.C. Douglas Park 2."
- 2. That the Clerk of the Town is authorized to effect any minor modifications, corrections or omissions, solely of an administrative, numerical, grammatical, semantical or descriptive nature to this by-law or its schedules after the passage of this by-law.

## Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 13<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2021.
