By-law No. 26-2022

Being a By-law to Appoint Tony Ranalli as Building Inspector for The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie

Whereas the *Building Code Act, 1992*, section 3 provides that the council of each municipality is responsible for the enforcement of the *Act* in the municipality and shall appoint such inspectors as are necessary for the enforcement of the *Act* in the areas in which the municipality has jurisdiction; and

Whereas it is desirable to appoint Tony Ranalli as a Building Inspector;

Now therefore the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie enacts as follows:

1. **That** Tony Ranalli is appointed Building Inspector for The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie, and he shall perform the duties and exercise the powers of Building Inspector in accordance with the provisions of the *Building Code Act, 1992*.
2. **That** Tony Ranalli is appointed as Municipal Law Enforcement Officer and Provincial Offences Officer, while in the discharge of his duties.
3. **That** the Clerk of the Town is authorized to effect any minor modifications, corrections or omissions, solely of an administrative, numerical, grammatical, semantical or descriptive nature to this by-law or its schedules after the passage of this by-law.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 22nd day of March, 2022.
