

The Municipal Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie

By-law No. 138-2022

Being a By-law to Amend Animal By-law No. 73-2021 (Dogs in Parks)

Whereas By-law No. 73-2021, was passed on May 31, 2021, to regulate the use of parks and beaches in the Town of Fort Erie; and

Whereas at the Council meeting held on September 19, 2022, Resolution No.4 was passed to amend By-law No.73-2021, as amended, to allow dogs on leashes in certain areas of all parks, excluding beaches; and

Whereas it is deemed desirable to amend By-law No. 73-2021 accordingly;

Now therefore the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie enacts as follows:

- **1. That** Part III Section 8 (7) of By-law No. 73-2021, as amended, is repealed and replaced with the following:
 - "(7) No person shall permit a dog to be on or in any cemetery, public beach, or park within the Town, except for dogs on leashes in the following areas of all Parks as defined in Parks & Beaches By-law No. 119-03, as amended, excluding beaches:
 - (i) in the parking lots;
 - (ii) on a designated pathway or hiking trail within a Park; and
 - (iii) in the "Passive Area" of a Park as defined in Parks & Beaches By-law No. 119-03, as amended;"
- 2. That the Clerk of the Town is authorized to effect any minor modifications, corrections or omissions, solely of an administrative, numerical, grammatical, semantical or descriptive nature to this by-law or its schedules after the passage of this by-law.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 17th day of October, 2022.
