## By-law No. 78-2023

---

### Being a By-law to Repeal By-law No. 18-2018

---

**Whereas** Section 5(3) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, as amended provides that a municipal power, including a municipality's capacity, rights, powers and privileges under section 9, shall be exercised by by-law unless the municipality is specifically authorized to do otherwise; and

**Whereas** By-law No. 18-2018 appointed Carol Schofield as Clerk of the Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie; and

**Whereas** Carol Schofield is no longer employed by the Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie; and

**Whereas** it is deemed desirable to repeal By-law No. 18-2018;

**Now therefore** the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie enacts as follows:

1. **That** By-law No. 18-2023 is repealed.
2. **That** this By-law take effect immediately after passage.
3. **That** the Clerk of the Town is authorized to affect any minor modifications, corrections or omissions, solely of an administrative, numerical, grammatical, semantical or descriptive nature to this by-law or its schedules after the passage of this by-law.
