The Environmental Conservation (EC) Overlay is applied to those areas within the Town that are deemed environmentally significant for various reasons. Development on such sites is prohibited.

Applicants may submit, to the Planning and Development Services Department, a request to have the EC Overlay removed. Requests to remove the overlay are brought forward to the Town's Environmental Advisory Committee for review. The Committee meets once a month, on the third Wednesday of the month. Requests must be submitted one week prior to the committee meeting to be put on the agenda. The Committee can either decide to remove the overlay, not remove the overlay or ask for an Environmental Impact Study to be undertaken in order to better understand the environmental features on the subject lands and the impact the development may have on them.

If an applicant is not satisfied with the decision of the EAC Committee, the applicant may request that Town Council reconsider their application.
