On behalf of the members of town Council and the residents of Fort Erie, I am delighted to welcome you to our community. Fort Erie is a welcoming, diverse

community with fascinating history, soul-enriching natural beauty and friendly people – truly a place for everyone.

Fort Erie has been at the crossroad of history for over 9,000 years, when our Indigenous peoples hunted, fished, traded and inhabited the area. After their conquest of New France, the British built the first fort on the Great Lakes at Fort Erie. It was destroyed near the end of the War of 1812, restored during the depression of the last century and remains a prominent national landmark. Fort Erie was also a significant stop on the Underground Railroad during the 19th century. One of the most celebrated freedom seekers to land on the shores of the Niagara River and live in our town was Josiah Henson, the inspiration for Harriet Beecher Stowe's "Uncle Tom's Cabin". In 1905, the Niagara Movement – precursor of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People – held its first meeting at the Erie Beach Hotel, about one mile west of the Old Fort.

Over the centuries, waves of immigrants and refugees from around the world have found freedom from persecution,

violence and slavery in Fort Erie and have begun a new life in Canada. All have added to the rich diversity of our community. They remain a constant reminder of our past through our landmarks, heritage sites, street names, tourist venues and community organizations and events.

Enjoy our 46-kilometres of waterfront on Lake Erie and the Niagara River, the greatest tree canopy and wildlife habitat in all of Niagara and our eclectic variety of provincially significant wetlands, geological formations, creeks, parks, flora and fauna. Our recreation trails are part of the Niagara Parks system, Trans-Canada Trail and Niagara Circle Route. Whether your interest is visiting historic sites, relaxing on a fantastic beach, fishing or sailing in world-class locations, cycling, canoeing or kayaking, incomparable bird-watching, golfing, snowshoeing or cross-country skiing or dining at one of our delightful restaurants that cater to a variety of tastes, we have it right here in Fort Erie.
