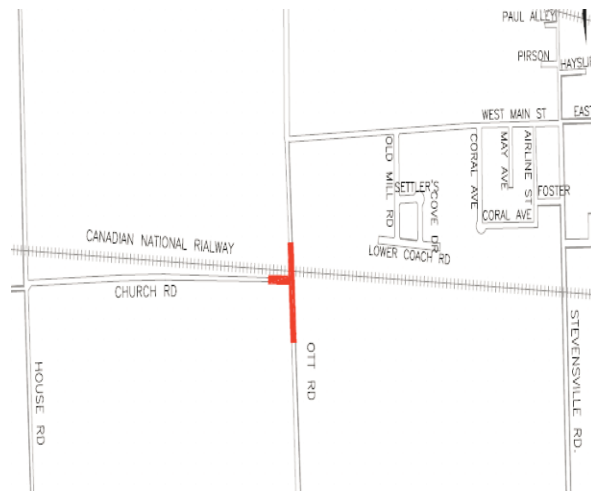


NOTICE OF STUDY COMMENCEMENT MUNICIPAL CLASS ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT FOR OTT ROAD RAILWAY CROSSING

What is this Study All About?

The Town of Fort Erie has identified a need to improve roadway safety at the Ott Road at-grade railway crossing and at the intersection of Ott Road and Church Road. Roadway and intersection improvement alternatives that will be considered as part of this study will include potential road realignments and/or the closure of Ott Road at the railway crossing, as well as other geometric and operational improvements.



How is this Study Being Undertaken?

The project is being completed as a **Schedule “B”** project in accordance with the **Municipal Class Environmental Assessment** (October 2000, amended in 2007, 2011 & 2015).

It is anticipated that one Public Information Centre (PIC) will be held during the study.

How can I Participate in this Study?

Public and technical agency consultation will be undertaken in developing the preferred solution.

The Town of Fort Erie invites residents to participate in this study process and learn more about the Ott Road at-grade railway crossing by attending a Public Information Centre (PIC) later in the study to discuss the details of the study, alternative and recommended solutions, and next steps.
