



Competition # 53-2018 Summer Student Employment- 2019

(Approximately April - September 2019)

The Corporation is now accepting applications for summer student employment opportunities in 2019. You may apply for more than one opportunity by applying for each separately.

Labourer - Parks, Cemeteries & Facilities: Physical labour; use of equipment including power and hand tools to support the operation and maintenance of Town parks, cemeteries, beaches, buildings and other public spaces.

Horticulture: Physical labour; use of equipment including power and hand tools prepare beds, plantings (flowers, trees, shrubs), general gardening, pruning and beautification.

Museums - Operations, including:

- Visitor services, public relations and gift shop operations; or
- Grounds/site maintenance; or
- Office support/data entry

Engineering: Students in civil engineering or equivalent who will assist Town staff in technical work to support the development, maintenance and operation of Town infrastructure services.

Administrative Support: Perform office administration, customer service, records management, and word processing and data entry duties.

In some positions schedules may include weekends and holidays. Successful candidates are expected to be available for the entire summer season. The hourly rate of pay is \$15.00.

To be eligible, you **must** be attending a post-secondary institution. A returning student who has worked for the Town in the past has preference over a new applicant. A student is limited to six periods of summer employment. Except for returning students, the assessment and selection of candidates includes a random element. Interviews will be conducted between February 19-28, 2019. Successful applicants will be asked to attend Orientation on May 14, 2019 prior to their hire date. [Click here](#) to apply.
