



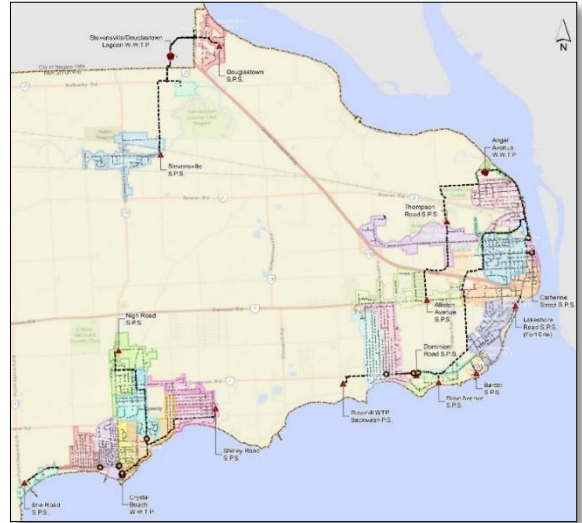
Notice of Study Completion 2017 Wastewater Master Plan and Pollution Prevention Control Plan Study Update

What is this Study All About?

The Town of Fort Erie has completed the 2017 Wastewater Master Plan and Pollution Prevention Control Plan (2017 MP&PPCP) study update. This update serves as a prioritized action plan for the Town to improve customer service levels and support long-term growth and sustainability of the Town’s wastewater infrastructure

How is this Study Being Undertaken?

The study was undertaken in accordance with Approach 1 of the Master Planning process as set out in the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (October 2000, as amended in 2007, 2011 and 2015), which is an approved process under the Ontario Environmental Assessment Act. This approach involves the preparation of a master plan document at the conclusion of Phases 1 and 2 of the Class EA process.



Review Process

This study is now initiating the 30-day public review period. During this period, the public is encouraged to review the final report and provide comments to the study’s Project Managers listed below.

The final report is available for public review at the Fort Erie Town Hall, 1 Municipal Centre Drive, Fort Erie, Ontario L2A 2S6 during regular business hours for a period of 30 calendar days, starting June 27, 2019.

If, after consulting with the Project Managers, you have significant unresolved concerns with the study, you have the right to make a request to the Ministry of the Environment, Conservation and Parks. The required form can be found on the Forms Repository website (<http://www.forms.ssb.gov.on.ca/>) by searching “Part II Order” or “012-2206E (the form ID number).
