In addition, the existing watermains and services will be replaced as well as full road reconstruction will be completed on Murray Street (Aberdeen Street to Central Avenue) and Battery Street (Lavina Street to Catherine Street).

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PRE-CONSTRUCTION SURVEYS:

OZA Inspection Ltd., a pre-construction survey company, has been hired by Peter's Excavating Inc., to conduct internal and external house inspections, to establish the pre-construction condition of your home.

The purpose of this inspection is to determine and document the extent of any cracking or other damage (if any) that exists prior to the commencement of construction. This information can then be used to determine the extent of the Contractor's responsibility in the unlikely event that damages to your property occur during construction.

These representatives will have identification with them.

WHAT TO EXPECT (During Construction):

Construction vehicles and related truck traffic is a necessary part of any construction project, so residents and businesses should expect a degree of noise, dust and short-term inconvenience.

Due to the scope of the work involved, the roadway at times may be open to local traffic only.

Detours and traffic signage will be adequately posted. Public services such as emergency services, garbage collection, and school buses will be advised of the construction works.

Driveway accessibility may be affected during construction however, every effort will be made to give you notice in advance should this occur.

With respect to sod restoration, please be advised that the Contractor will place, water and roll sod once materials are available and weather permits. To ensure proper root growth, the homeowner is requested to continue to water the new sod after the initial watering by the Contractor.

Area residents may experience some slight vibration due to the work being done. As a precaution, we recommend the removal of small, light objects from shelving and walls.

At times there may be some inconvenience to you during the construction period and we respectfully request your patience and cooperation during this period.
