***Note – test all smoke alarms and carbon monoxide alarms monthly.

Portable fire extinguishers should be class ABC and be mounted in an easily accessible location. Monthly inspections include checking the extinguisher for any visible damage, ensuring that the pressure gauge is at an acceptable level, and that the nozzle is not obstructed.
